

## **Assistant Professor Position**

The Department of Institutional Analysis and Public Management of Università Bocconi, Milan (Italy), [www.unibocconi.eu](http://www.unibocconi.eu), invites applications for a tenure-track position at the junior faculty level, with special emphasis on the areas of

- Public Economics;
- Health;
- Education;
- Social security;
- Law and Economics.

The appointment will start with the academic year 2011-2012 (Fall 2011).

The selected candidates will be interviewed at the 2011 ASSA meeting in Denver or in another appropriate academic venue and may be subsequently invited to give a job talk at Bocconi during the January-March 2011 period. There is also the possibility that a candidate will be directly invited for a fly-out to Bocconi.

Contracts will run up to seven years, subject to renewal after the first four years. There is also the possibility of promotion to a tenured position at the end of the period. There are no teaching obligations in the first year. Applicants must be fluent in English. Knowledge of Italian is not required though it is encouraged if the candidate is appointed to the position.

Responsibilities include teaching and, most importantly, productivity in research. The appointed person is expected to publish in international refereed journals.

Applicants should have –or be close to completing – a Ph.D. and will have demonstrated strong potential in research and teaching.

Compensation and teaching load are competitive with other top European academic institutions.
