### Program Overview

#### 1<sup>st</sup> year

- 8 method courses (i.e. econometrics, quantitative methods for business studies)
- Selection of one major track among 4 options:
  - Accounting
  - Organization
  - Strategy
  - Technology
 (each track consists of 4 specialized courses)

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> year

- 2 method courses (networks methods and experimental methods)
- selection of one minor track (among the 4 options of the majors: each track 4 courses)
- 6 elective courses

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year

- Thesis development and dissertation defense

Several PhD Faculty members got international awards and 6 of them received the Bocconi "Research Profile" award in 2015.
