



The Department of Policy Analysis and Public Management at Bocconi University is inviting applications from political scientists for a faculty position at the assistant professor level, for appointment on September 1, 2017. We are particularly interested in applications in the field of comparative politics. Proficiency in quantitative and/or formal methods is appreciated, given the direction of development of the political science group.

Bocconi University is a leading institution for economics and related disciplines in Continental Europe, and it is currently expanding in the area of political science. As part of this development, in 2015 Bocconi launched a Bachelor in International Politics and Government, which has immediately established itself as an ambitious and competitive bachelor program, attracting over 300 applications from international students for the 60 available positions. Political science is a major field also in the Ph.D. Program in Public Policy and Administration, launched in 2014. In addition, political science is an increasingly important component of the well-established master's programs in Economics and Social Sciences and Economics and Management of Government and International Organizations, highly selective programs that attract the best master students in Europe.

Bocconi provides an ideal interdisciplinary research environment. The Department of Policy Analysis and Public Management combines faculty from several social sciences (economics, political science, sociology, history, demography and public administration), who shares an interest in policy-relevant research. The Politics and Institutions Unit, at the Dondena Center for Research in Social Dynamics and Public Policy, brings together scholars from different departments at Bocconi, who contribute to research in political science and political economy. The Politics and Institutions Unit is also one of the founders of the European Political Economy Consortium, an initiative that will significantly increase the interactions and collaborations of researchers in political science and political economy across Europe.

The successful candidate is expected to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The excellent terms of employment are competitive. Bocconi University is located in Italy's most vibrant center, Milan, a historical and cosmopolitan city in a metro area of 3 million, conveniently set near the Alps and just eighty miles from the Mediterranean sea.

Applications are due by September 20, 2016. Review will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Campus visits are going to be scheduled for November and/or early December 2016.

To ensure full consideration, applicants must submit:

- a. a scientific curriculum (including a list of titles and publications);
 - b. titles, publications and documents which the candidates intend to submit for this evaluation ;
 - c. list of highly qualified academic referees providing a reference letter
- via the on-line e-form with pdf attachments which can be found at www.unibocconi.eu/jobmarket.

To complete the online process, applicants will have to include three letters of recommendation. The letters should be sent by the referees to recruiting@unibocconi.it by September 25, 2016.

Applicants who wish to arrange a preliminary interview at the APSA conference should submit their application according to the procedure outlined above by August 2, 2016.
