

Fee reductions

LLM EBSL 2021-2022

The LLM EBSL makes available, on the basis of merit criteria, up to 8 partial fee reductions for candidates for the LLM in European Business and Social Law (EBSL) a.y. 2021-2022 who possess an excellent academic profile.

1. Requisites

The fee reductions are reserved for LLM EBSL applicants with an excellent academic and professional profile, who satisfy the following conditions:

- They do not receive any other scholarship or financial sponsorship to finance the LLM EBSL.
- They possess all the requirements to apply for the LLM EBSL.

Fee reductions are awarded to candidates, on the basis of overall merit assessment of the following elements:

- Earlier titles (degrees and grades)
- Motivation letter
- Work experience
- CV

Fee reductions are reserved only and exclusively to candidates who have submitted their application for admission to the LLM 2021-2022, accompanied by the required documentation within the deadlines, and who have been admitted to the LLM EBSL according to the general admission criteria.

2. Conditions

The beneficiaries of the reductions must guarantee regular attendance of the LLM EBSL in accordance with the methods agreed with the Director and Coordinator of the LLM EBSL. The beneficiaries are required to exercise a student representative role within the cohort.

3. Incompatibility

The fee reductions cannot be combined with any scholarship, prize or other financing even if these are provided by other companies or other public and private bodies. To this end, the beneficiaries of the reductions will have to issue self-certification attesting the absence of such cumulation.

4. Decisions

An interview may be requested with the shortlisted candidates – this is up to the discretion of the LLM Admissions Committee. The outcome will be announced by 30 June 2021. Decisions on fee reductions are taken by the EBSL Admissions Committee and are unappealable.
