The Judging Committee of the competition by exam and academic titles for 1 spot for Research Grants related to sector 13/D1 STATISTICS (Scientific Sector SECS-S/01 STATISTICS) with a duration of one year at Department of Decision Sciences of the Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" of Milan is made up of:

- prof. Daniele Durante, Assistant Professor
- prof. Igor Prünster, Professor
- prof. Giacomo Zanella, Assistant Professor .

The Committee met via conference call on March 15, 2021, at 3pm to decide the scores to assign to the research and academic titles and publications.

The Committee has appointed Prof. Igor Prünster as President and Prof. Daniele Durante as Secretary.

The Committee took note of the regulations set out in the notice of competition that the maximum points to be assigned are as follows:

- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of CV, academic titles and research;
- 30 points out of 100 for the evaluation of scientific publications presented;
- 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation by interview.

Only candidates who achieve a minimum of 40 points in the evaluation of CV, titles and publications will be admitted to be evaluated by interview.

Having read the applications and titles submitted by the candidates of the competition, which were all compliant with what was set out in the competition notice, the following points were assigned:

The candidate Maria Fernanda Gil-Leyva has obtained a MSc in Mathematics with specialization in Statistics and Probability from UNAM, Mexico in 2015 and is PhD candidate in PhD Program in Mathematics (area Statistics and Probability) at IIMAS-UNAM, Mexico since 2016; she has submitted her PhD thesis and the final defense will take place by July 2021. Her research interests concern Bayesian nonparametric statistics and are perfectly in line with the research project of this call. The candidate has one publication on a prestigious international journal, one in a collective volume and several working papers.

The candidate Hamed Sabahno obtained a MSc in Industrial Engineering from the Sharif University of Technology in 2007 and a PhD in Industrial Engineering from the Shahed University in 2020. His research interests concern mainly Industrial Engineering topics. He has 8 papers published on international journal and only 1 of them on a statistics journal. His research profile is of good quality but not in line with the sector object of this call.
