Corporate Criminal Law and White Collar Crimes

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Editorial Board of *Bocconi Legal Papers* selects papers to be published in hard copy every six months. The articles published in *Bocconi Legal Papers* follow Bocconi University School of Law's long-standing tradition, which focuses on «Business Law».

In particular, for the release of its Number 11, expected to be in June 2018, the Law Journal is collecting contributions related to the specific topic of «**Corporate Criminal Law and White Collar Crime**». The subject in question, to be interpreted broadly, concerns a branch of criminal law which is in constant evolution and is of high relevance for today's modern economic and social life, sensitive to changes in the world of business, markets and consumers.

The selection of papers will be based on their consistency with the proposed theme, their structure – according to the BLP' Guidelines –, their originality and coherence.

ADDRESSEES

Bocconi Legal Papers addresses exponents of the academic world, as well as Ph.D. candidates in legal matters and practitioners (lawyers, judges, notaries). Furthermore, papers written by law students who are about to conclude their studies will be taken into consideration as well, and one of them may be published in each volume (in these regards, priority will be given to papers written by students attending Law Schools other

than Bocconi University).

REVIEW PROCESS AND PUBLICATION

For the forthcoming issue of June 2018, only papers submitted by **5th April 2018** will be accepted. However, authors are encouraged to provide the Editorial Board with the Abstract of their contribution preferably by **15th March 2018**. Nevertheless, papers received after such deadline will remain eligible for future publication in Number 12 (to be released in December 2018) or on *Bocconi Legal Papers* website.

In order to be published in the printed version, papers should:

- not exceed the length of **15,000 words** (approximately). Longer papers will be considered for the on-line version;
- be written either in Italian or English language;
- follow the «Submission Guidelines», especially with regards to the thereby specified standard of citation, favoring footnotes rather than endnote format (no final bibliography is required);
- include an **abstract** written in English of approximately **150 - 250 words**;
- be submitted in Microsoft Word format (**.docx**).

All the papers received will be subject to the Law Journal's revision process, articulated in three stages. First, contributions are revised by an Articles Editor and, secondly, double-checked by an Executive Editor. Lastly, all papers undertake a scientific control conducted by the Advisory Board composed of professors from Bocconi University faculty.
