
Gabriel Pereira Pundrich - PhD in Accounting (2014, UTS Sydney) .MSc. in Computer Engineering (Politecnico di Milano) and BA of Computer Engineering (Brazil) - Currently . Post Doc at the Department of Accounting, Bocconi University - Area of interest : Auditing, Financial Reporting and Disclosure.

Candidates OMISSIS and OMISSIS have been excluded from evaluation as not yet holding a PhD.

Candidate OMISSIS area of interest is in Finance, clearly far from the fields of interest of our department. The Recruiting Committee decided not to invite him for a fly-out.

Candidate Gabriel Pereira Pundrich has research interests in fields that are of interest of the Accounting Department too (Auditing, Financial Reporting and Disclosure) . He has already two good publications in a A-level US journals with his thesis supervisor. This is quite rare among young PhDs in the Accounting area, and puts him ahead of a lot of competitors in the job market. His technical background in computer science makes him also well suited to contribute in the emerging research field of content analysis for very large data sets. Gabriel gave an effective seminar presentation : the presentation of his job market paper was very clear and well organised.

The Recruiting Committee unanimously declares Gabriel Pereira Pundrich winner of the Call and asks the Pro Rector, through the Head of Department, to offer him an Assistant Professor position inside the Department of Accounting.
