

Master of Science 2020-2021 AY EARLY SESSION - Bocconi applicants

Admissions Ranking

For the Early Session, the admissions ranking is created **only** if the number of applications exceeds 60% of available spots, and **only** for the program(s) that exceed this limit.

It means that candidates will be admitted if the total number of applications received for their first choice program is lower than 60% of available places.

Otherwise, an admission ranking will be defined considering, as the first parameter, **the weighted average of grades** over the credit value for exams passed and registered by **July 2019**. Please note that the weighted average of grades taken into consideration for admissions purposes might be slightly different compared to the one shown on "Punto Blu". This is due to the fact that, for admissions purposes, exams divided into modules are considered separately.

The highest students in the ranking (on a quantitative basis) will be admitted with no further evaluation.

The last 20% of the slots available will be assigned after a specific evaluation of double the number of candidates compared to the places to be awarded. The candidates' evaluation will consider both the weighted average of grades and a **qualitative evaluation** of individual profiles, based on CVs and personal statements that have been UPLOADED by the deadline of the application period.

Applicants who have been deemed not admitted to the first choice program will be considered for their subordinate choices (if expressed), following the above-indicated procedure.
