Overall assessment:




The Commission unanimously declares the candidate **Carrera Alberto** to be the winner of the competition with effect from **April 1, 2019**.


The Commission passed this report to the Faculty and Research Division of Università Commerciale Luigi Bocconi for subsequent compliance.
