What to do if you do not feel well

If you are in a Bocconi residence and you feel sick of any Covid-19 symptom (fever, sore throat, fatigue, loss of taste and smell), please proceed as listed below:

- 1. CONTACT THE RESIDENCE MANAGEMENT.
- 2. Call your doctor, who will indicate to you if necessary to stay in isolation and, based on the symptoms that might appear, will tell you whether to perform a swab for SARS-CoV2.
- 3. If you do not have a doctor, you can call a **Medico di Continuità Assistenziale** (former "Guardia Medica") to the phone number: **116117**, available: from **8.00** am to **8.00** pm during weekdays and on Saturdays and Sundays and from **8.00** pm to **8.00** am every night. As an alternative, during the day, everyday, you can call the contact center of **ATS Milan** by calling the number **+39 02 85781**, or the Department of Infectious Diseases by calling the numbers **+39 02 85783848 02 85784090** from Monday to Friday during business hours.
- 4. Should the symptoms be severe and should you need immediate assistance, you may request external rescue by calling the emergency number: **112**

Or you can request the intervention of **Croce Bianca Milan** during the days and hours in which the service is available (Monday to Friday from 9.30 am to 5.30 pm), by calling the number: **342 0106355** or **02 58363015**

In these cases please always coordinate with the RESIDENCE MANAGEMENT, that may request the assistance you need by calling the numbers provided above.

- 5. IF YOU MUST STAY IN ISOLATION:
 - The residence manager will communicate your conditions to your roommates;
- The residence manager will verify that your room is eligible for isolation: in case the room should not be eligible and until availability, he will offer you an alternative place to your roommates or also to you if necessary;
- will apply the sanitization protocol in your room, your apartment and your residence;
- will support you in every practical need (grocery shopping, laundry, etc.) that you might have during your period of isolation.
