ACADEMICS

STUDY PLAN: individual **study plans developed** in accordance with the DD agreement signed with your home istitution, matching home courses with Bocconi ones. Once the study plan is finalized, no changes will be allowed. Credit system is **ECTS equivalent**.

ELECTIVE COURSES SELECTION: carried out online **before arrival** with the possibility to change courses during the "add/drop period".

CLASS ATTENDANCE: as a general rule, attendance is not strictly mandatory. Students are strongly encouraged to discuss attendance requirements with Professors. <u>Check the academic calendar.</u>

EXAMS: Exams must be sat on official dates at Bocconi (mandatory registration before the exam). Grades: on a scale of 30 with 18/30 (minimum passing grade).

LANGUAGES: required to pass two foreign language exams at Bocconi. The first foreign language will be English (exit level: C1 Business); the second language will be Italian (exit level: A2) while native Italian speakers can decide between French, German and Spanish (exit level: B1). The Bocconi Language Center may recognize home school exams and international certificates.

INTERNSHIP: curricular internship in Italy or abroad is a mandatory element (6/8 credits). Minimum length is **8 full-time weeks**. Previously completed internships, if in line with the student's course of study/duration requirements may be validated.

THESIS: to be written and defended at Bocconi (2 types: **Research or Analytical/Descriptive thesis - validity of 18/20 ECTS)** according to the rules set in the DD Agreement between Bocconi and the home school. DD students can contact the MSc Director/Supervisor who will provide assistance on the topic. All students are required to pay a graduation contribution of around $370 \in$ to finalize the registration to the graduation session. For BSc, there is a Final Paper with no defense.

IMPORTANT: students who **applied to Bocconi directly** and **Italian Bachelor graduates** will not be accepted into the DD Program.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

- **APRIL-MAY** : Home school **nomination**; **MAY-JUNE** : students' online **application**;
- JULY-AUGUST: study plan creation and electives choices;
- Early **SEPTEMBER**: orientation and **1**st **semester starts** Check the official UB Calendar
- DECEMBER, JANUARY, FEBRUARY: exam session
- and electives add/drop period;
- FEBRUARY: 2nd semester start;
- MAY-JUNE: exam session;
- JULY, OCTOBER, DECEMBER and MARCH: graduation session

STATUS @ BOCCONI: Double Degree students are considered **regularly-enrolled Bocconi students** and they have to comply with all Bocconi rules and regulations, but some exceptions may apply. Double Degree students are exempted from paying the university tuition fees and cannot apply for Bocconi scholarships.

DIVERSITY & INCLUSION: Bocconi University is committed to fostering social mobility, inclusivity, diversity and sustainability. PRACTICAL INFO

VISA: Prior to their arrival in Italy, **non-EU students** must apply and obtain a multiple entry study visa for Italy. They have to submit their application well in advance since it takes time for the visa to be released. Italian Consulates directory: <u>http://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en</u>

PERMIT OF STAY: non-EU students must apply for the Permit of Stay within 8 working days from their arrival in Italy. Info sessions upon arrival.

HEALTH & SECURITY: non-EU students must have health insurance coverage with international validity while studying in Italy to be approved for the permit of stay. EU students are required to have the European Health Insurance Card or a similar private insurance policy with international validity to benefit from health service coverage.

INTERNATIONAL SOS: Bocconi offers medical, safety and security advice to students 24/7. Access yoU@B agenda>International Relations>International SOS to get more info.

STUDENT ID CARD: distributed upon arrival and activated as debit card.

LIVING COSTS: in Milan between 600€ (shared bedroom in private apartments) and 1.400€ (entire flat) per month. Bocconi has **housing facilities** for international students. Meal at the **university canteen** for about 5€ and transportation 22€/month pass for <27 students and 39€ for ≥27.
