1. Does the University provide accommodation for international students?

Exchange students have the chance to apply for accommodation in Bocconi dorms. Housing is not guaranteed and rooms are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis. Further information can be found at the link www.ir.unibocconi.eu/housingisd.

2. What types of accommodation options are there?

Bocconi Residence Halls provided by the university or Private Solutions to be arranged autonomously.

3. Where can I find housing fees for Bocconi dorms?

Housing fees for Bocconi dorms will be available in the online application.

4. Is it possible to have reduced fees?

Reduced fees are not available for incoming exchange students.

5. How do I apply for accommodation?

You will be able to apply for a place in one of our dorms through our online exchange application (www.ir.unibocconi.eu/exchangeapplication), which can be accessed with the PIN and PASSWORD sent by email to you and your home university coordinator. Spots are limited and assigned on a first-come-first-served basis, according to the list of applications received. A security deposit of 400 euro is required to process your housing application.

6. How can I look for a private accommodation?

Usually students live in one of the residences recommended by our office or in private apartments. If you are interested in finding an apartment by yourself, with Italians or other exchange students, you can check a list of rooms/apartments available on the notice boards around the Bocconi buildings.

The process of finding an apartment or a room can often be difficult. We recommend that you book a temporary accommodation for at least a couple of days. You can also have a look at the links available in the 'Apartment Hunting' section of our website, www.ir.unibocconi.eu/housingisd.

7. Is any pick-up service organized from the airport to the dorm?
