This LL.M. meets the current need for **new professional figures** who are able to apply **existing legal tools to digital environments** and create **innovative, legal solutions** adapted to the ever-changing information and knowledge economy.

2 This is a unique and innovative program that provides current and future professionals with **in-depth knowledge** and **cutting-edge skills**. It enables them to deal with legal questions emerging from the development, use and implementation of Internet technologies.

3 A **faculty**, drawn from world-renowned academic institutions, high-tech companies, specialized law firms, national and international regulatory authorities, think tanks and intergovernmental organizations, provides those interested in specializing in the law of Internet technologies with an **internationally acknowledged learning experience** and an **unprecedented competitive advantage** in the field.

4 A community of University and LL.M. Alumni is active all over the world. LL.M. holders have access to this **extensive network** for professional and employment opportunities.

5 Students can participate in **interactive campus** life with many high-level conferences and events every year in a dynamic, physical and wired environment. In addition, Bocconi is located in downtown **Milan**, a **dynamic cultural and business hub** in the heart of Europe.





LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The LL.M. in Law of Internet Technology focuses on all key areas of interest for lawyers and legal practitioners dealing with innovation, the Internet and technological development.

The program is unique in providing a thorough **understanding of international legal issues emerging in the digital age**, including **intellectual property protection and competition rules**.

Emphasis is placed on the freedom of contracts, individuals and businesses in digital environments.

The final goal is to prepare tomorrow's professionals to find cutting-edge solutions to the legal questions emerging from fast-paced technological development and digital activities.

APPLICANT PROFILE AND CAREERS

The LL.M. is addressed to lawyers and current and future legal practitioners who wish to get an **internationally acknowledged curriculum** and the skills to start or further develop a promising career in law and technology in the digital era.

The program prepares participants for careers in legal practice dealing with information technology, technological sectors and digital environments at:

- digital businesses, information technology corporations and companies relying on digital assets in general
- domestic and international law firms with specialized practices
- governments and public regulatory institutions
- universities and think tanks, as well as non-governmental organizations



PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The LL.M., **taught entirely in English**, is offered in priority as a full-time program (**12 months**), but a part-time version (2 years) is also available. This professional program features prominently hands-on activities. Close relations with specialized law firms, digital and high-tech companies and national or international regulatory institutions is ensured, also in view of internships and clinical work.

For the full-time program, all courses take place **from September 2019 until April 2020** and all practical activities take place between May and July 2020.

The program awards **60 ECTS** credits in total.

Each module and sub-module will be taught by top-tier experts and specialists of each subject.

- Internet Technologies
- Jurisdiction and Dispute Resolution on the Internet
- Intellectual Property and Competition in the Digital Age
- Data Law and Data-Driven Innovation Law
- Free Speech and Human Rights in the Cyber Space
- Legal English Drafting

6 COMPULSORY COURSES

Students may complete a **curricular internship** consistent with the educational objectives of the LL.M. in the final part of the program. Alternatively, students may choose a **clinical work**, a short-term assignment by an external partner focusing on specific subjects. They may also choose to complete an individual research paper (final thesis).

APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Online application will open in **October 2018** and close on **June 26, 2019**. The results of the selection process will be communicated in July 2019.

In order to be evaluated, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- a 5-year Integrated Master of Arts in Law (if from an Italian university), or eligible non-Italian degree (if from a university abroad)
- English knowledge at least at the B2 level

The selection process is based on the evaluation of a dossier including:

- Academic curriculum
- Curriculum vitae
- Personal statement
- Reference letters (up to 2)
- Interview (if needed)

TUITION AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Tuition and fees for the 2019-2020 edition is € 16,000 and include course materials and access to Bocconi facilities. A limited number of scholarships may be provided.
