



## INFORMATION AIMED AT ALL PEOPLE ACCESSING THE BOCCONI UNIVERSITY BUILDINGS

1. It is required to stay at home in the case of fever (over 37.5°C) or other flu symptoms and to call the family doctor and the health authorities.
2. It is forbidden to enter or remain on the premises of Bocconi University when, hazardous conditions exist, even after entry. i.e.: flu symptoms, fever, return from at risk areas or contact with people who have tested positive for Covid.
3. It is required to respect all the provisions of the Authorities and the behavioral measures established by Bocconi when accessing Bocconi premises (in particular, maintaining a safe distance, complying with the rules of hand hygiene and maintaining correct hygiene behaviors).
4. It is required to promptly and responsibly inform the Bocconi Departments involved in the case of any flu symptoms during my work or study activities on Bocconi premises, making sure I remain at an adequate distance from the people present.
5. Body temperature will be checked at the entrances of Bocconi buildings: and, if this temperature is higher than 37.5°C, It will not be allowed access. People in this conditions will have to contact a doctor as soon as possible and follow his/her instructions.
6. People will not be able to access the premises of Bocconi University if they are subject to quarantine or isolation and they will have to respect all the conditions provided by the regulations in force at the time before re-entering the premises of Bocconi University.
7. In Bocconi buildings access is allowed only to people in possession of a Covid-19 green certification ("Green Pass"): there are checks by the staff in charge, which may also include the control of identity card.

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
